Grazing Rules:

Pointways Pony Club grazing is only offered to current financial members.

Pony Club members have preference over Facility Members and Adult Members
At anytime a Facility User can be asked to leave the grazing to accommodate a pony club member.

A probation period of 2 months will apply and any horse that is not deemed compatible will be asked to leave.

Existing grazing rights do not guarantee a place should the horse be changed – reapplication is required.

Any sub-lease of a horse is to be approved by the committee.

Grazers that are pony club members must participate in 70% of rallies to retain their grazing privilege

Horses that are known windsuckers will be assessed on an individual basis by the committee and if allowed onto the grounds must at all times, wear a preventative collar.

All applications must be approved by the committee. Forms can be obtained from the Secretary. All applications must supply a reference from previous grazing facility.

Grazers must observe the paddock movements at all times determined by the grazing officer.

The grazing member must pay grazing fee by automatic bank payment one month in advance. This is to be done on the first of each month and must be arranged before the member takes up grazing.

Failure to pay grazing fees will result in removal of grazing privileges.

One months notice in writing must be given to the committee before terminating the agreement.

Drenching and pasting will be arranged by the grazing Officer. All grazing members must meet on the arranged day/time. Should you not attend drenching the club will charge an additional drench attendance fee which is currently \$50.00.

New horses joining must be drenched no more than 5 days prior to coming onto the property. Owner must produce a Vet Certificate or proof of purchase to this effect.

Hard feed is not to be fed within the same paddock as grazing horses for obvious safety reasons.

Hay will be supplied at the grazing officer's discretion.

It is the responsibility of all grazing members to report any damage caused to fencing troughs etc. including pens and yards. The pony club reserves the right to ask the owner of the horse to reimburse or compensate the pony club for any damage caused.

Should the grazing officer or any committee member determine that the horse described in this agreement require veterinary treatment and be unable to contact me then a Veterinarian can be called at my expense.

Grazing members are on a roster for cleaning yards etc and trough cleaning from time to time when requested by the committee.

No-one may disregard the Grazing Officers instructions

Horses must be checked at least 4 times a week by owner or appointee
Neglect or ill treatment will not be tolerated at anytime. The wellbeing of the horse on Pointways grounds is a direct reflection on the Club and its members.

All floats/trucks parked on grounds must supply to the secretary registration number, contact phone numbers and when asked by the committee to move on event days and any other time specified by committee.

In the event that these rules are not adhered to Pointways reserves the right to remove the grazing privilege.
Pointways Pony Club has the right to ask the owner to remove the horse if it is deemed extremely troublesome to other horses grazers and people or does not fit in with communal grazing.

It is a privilege to graze at Pointways grounds and it is in the best interest of all grazers that every one ensures the Safety and welfare of all horses grazing.
