- The event is held in Cambridge over two days and show jumping is on Grass.
- Whilst in Cambridge riders are Billeted to local families in the area overnight.

Eligibility Criteria:

NZPCA General Regulations Sep 2014 (Extract)

- 15.4 Rally Attendance for Examinations and Competitions: The Riding Member must have attended a minimum number of working rallies in the twelve (12) months preceding the examination date or closing date for entries to inter Club, inter Area, National or International competition.

 a. Riders who do not hold a certificate must attend a minimum of five (5) working rallies. Three (3) of these attendances must be the combination of rider and mount that are sitting the examination or entering the competition.
- b. Riders who hold a D or D+ or C certificate must attend a minimum of five (5) working rallies. Three (3) of these attendances must be the combination of rider and mount that are sitting the examination or entering the competition.
- c. Riders who hold a C+ certificate must attend a minimum of four (4) working rallies. Two (2) of these attendances must be the combination of rider and mount that are sitting the examination or entering the competition.
- d. Riders who hold a B or H and A certificates must attend a minimum of three (3) working rallies. One (1) of these attendances must be the combination of rider and mount that are sitting the examination or entering the competition.

Rules

- 1. The 5 Rally rule applies, including the draft riders.
- 2. All entry forms must be signed by your District Commissioner.
- 3. The events are judged under S.J.N.Z. rules.
- 4. Team Manager's are responsible in all aspects for their team riders, horses, equipment, vehicles, riders and draft riders' safety and conduct. They are Cambridge Pony Club's only point of contact from 8.00 am of the first day's competition to the completion of the event.
- 5. Any rider injured during the Championships that requires hospital treatment must produce written clearance from a Doctor before continuing in the competition.
- 6. All changes prior to the event are to be in writing, and must be signed by the District Commissioner. Any changes during the event must be in writing signed by the Team Manager and must be delivered prior to 8:00am on the first day of competition.
- 7. A rider may upgrade one ring only. A letter from the District Commissioner stating that this rider is capable of competing at that level must accompany the team information. An intermediate rider may upgrade to the senior ring on a hack only. A rider may not downgrade under any circumstances.
- 8. In addition to rule 7, a rider may only trial up a ring if there is only one or no riders eligible at that level.
- 9. A rider aged between 17 and 21 may compete on a pony in the senior ring if it is their normal pony club mount and qualifies under the 5 rally rule. If a rider is competing in the senior ring on a pony he or she must have a letter from the District Commissioner confirming this with the team information form.
- 10. Draft Riders - are surplus to their own team requirements and cannot enter as individuals.
 - All draft rider requests must be submitted to the event secretary on the official form and will be allocated to other teams at Cambridge Pony Club's sole discretion. Any draft riders competing otherwise than in accordance with these rules will be eliminated.
- 11. Uniform, please refer to the NZPCA rule book. Cambridge Pony Club will not perform gear checks. Team Managers are responsible to present their teams in your club's uniform which must include long sleeves for jumping and safety helmets with serial numbers as listed in the NZPCA rules. All helmets must have the current official NZPCA tag. Cambridge Pony Club reserves the right to spot check a rider's helmet. Team Managers must ensure that riders remain in this uniform whilst riding on the grounds and including the presentation. A team uniform description must be completed and returned with all other team information.
- 12. Competitors compete in program order only.

To ensure the continuation of this vital component of the Show Jumping Championships, the following is a guideline to assist in making your visit to Cambridge an enjoyable experience both for your team and your hosts.

- 1. Your team will be billeted for the duration of the Champs. Please state clearly on your entry form the nights (Sunday\Monday) you will be staying. Teams travelling a long distance have the option of staying Tuesday.
- 2. The billet is for the Team Manager and 6 riders. If there are circumstances that involve bringing extra people, this must be discussed with the host BEFORE arrival. For additional parents, supporters etc, details of accommodation available in Cambridge can be obtained from the Cambridge Information Centre (07) 823-3456.
- 3. Please make contact with your host well before the event to discuss available grazing, stabling facilities etc.
- 4. Your host is not expected to feed your team or your horses during your stay. Please make sure you bring sufficient food with you.
- 5. Please ensure all facilities you use are left as you found them.
- 6. Use stabling, grazing as directed by the host and park trucks as directed. Check in advance how much parking is available Please keep the number of vehicles to a minimum.
